Shiplap Fixing

The Aliwood cladding system features an interlocking shiplap design that allows for quick and easy concealed fixings. The cladding board is screwed directly to the frame or to a cavity system and the next cladding board is interlocked. The shiplap offers a clean and concealed look with uniform shadow lines that gives an architectural feature when installed horizontally or vertically.
